Today, March 11, 2011, the U.S. Army gave permission to the Fort Monroe Authority to rent housing to Department of Defense Civilians and military retirees from all branches of the service.

The current rental special for a residential home is: All utilities will be included except for telephone, internet, and cable. Lease must be signed before by April 30, 2011 to qualify. This limited time offer is available on one year leases only.

March 10, 2011, Fort Monroe, Old Point Comfort, Hampton Virginia, the Fort Monroe Authority continues steps to execute the 2008 Reuse Plan. The U.S. Army has granted the early transfer of historic properties in the Fort Monroe National Historic Landmark District.

The Colonial Revival duplexes were built between 1906 and 1911 to accommodate officers coming to the Coastal Artillery School. Designed from Quartermasters General's plans, they are located near the Historic Chamberlin and some include views of the water and marina. The two and three bedroom homes are available now.
