

CASEMATE MUSEUM MOA



The Casemate Museum was established in June 1951 to exhibit Jefferson Davis cell. Museum staff includes 5 government employees, 1 contract guard, and 30 volunteers. Collection includes 23 guns and 383 objects on exhibit. Visitation pre 9/11 was 62,000 and post 9/11 it averages 32,479.
