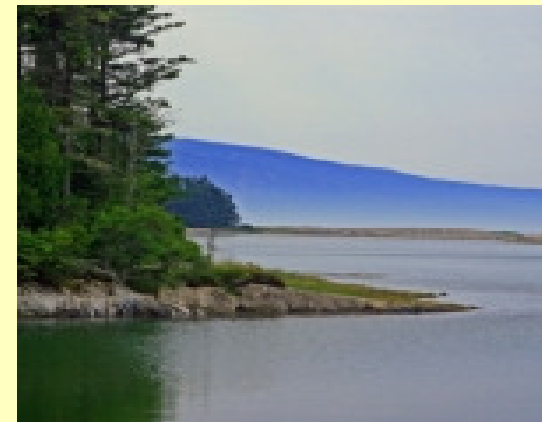

Traditional Model – Acadia National Park

- *NPS Full Fee Ownership*
- *NPS Staff and Operations*
- *No Management Partner*
- *NPS Resource Protection and Interpretation*
- *Annual ONPS Funding and Service-Wide Competitive Capital Funding*

Partial Ownership – Governors Island National Monument

- *NPS Owns Castle Williams and Fort Jay*
- *State/City Agency (GIPEC) Plans Reuse and Development of Deed Restricted Remainder*
- *ONPS Funding for NM – State and Local Funding for GIPEC*
- *NPS Interpretation Outside NM Boundary*

Shared Ownership – Harriet Tubman NHS (Proposed)

- *NPS Holds Preservation Easements on Historic Properties*
- *NPS Interpretive Staffing*
- *1:1 Matching Grants for Capital Improvements*
- *Shared Maintenance Costs*
- *Cooperative Agreement*
- *NPS General Management Plan*

Ownership Only – Theodore Roosevelt Inaugural NHS

- *NPS Owns Property*
- *TR Inaugural Site Foundation Operates Site*
- *NPS Provides 2/3 costs for Operations and Technical Assistance*
- *Cooperative Agreement*

No Ownership/NPS Administers Site – Boston African American NHS

- *15 Non-NPS Owned Structures*
- *NPS Conducts Exterior Tours*
- *NPS TA and ONPS Funding*
- *Cooperative Agreement With Museum of African American History*

No Ownership/Joint Operations – Harriet Tubman NHP (Proposed)

- 1:1 Cost Share on Visitor Facility With Maryland***
- NPS Staffing for Interpretation/Cost Share on Maintenance***
- 1:1 Matching grants to Public and Private Organizations for Conservation Easements on Privately-Owned Historic Lands***
- NPS Interpretation of Related Sites***

Affiliated Areas – NJ Pinelands National Reserve and Lower East Side Tenement Museum

- NPS Provides Financial and Technical Assistance as Authorized by Legislation***
- Secretary Appoints a Representative to the Pinelands Commission/Exercises Approval of Management Plan***
- Non Profit Operates LOEA Museum***
- NPS Conducts General Management Plan***
