#### Directions to Fort Monroe:

#### Entrance to Fort Monroe:

Visitors without military decals must stop at the gate for a day pass, which requires a government issued picture ID for each adult and a valid vehicle registration. All vehicles must have current inspection stickers. If you arrive in a rental car, you must present your rental agreement. Stay in the right lane at the gate and enter via McNair Dr. After providing all requested identification, you will be given a "Day Pass" allowing visitation throughout Ft. Monroe for the day. NOTE: Maximum speed limit on Ft. Monroe is 25 mph and it is strictly enforced.

#### Directions to the Chamberlin:

after security gate, continue straight on McNair Dr. and enter the Chamberlin parking lot.

#### Directions from Richmond

- Take I-64 East towards Norfolk/Williamsburg/Virginia Beach to Hampton, VA
- Take Exit 268 (Rte 169 East/Mallory St/Ft. Monroe). NOTE: Last exit prior to entering the Hampton Roads Bridge Tunnel
- Left at the light onto S Mallory St. (.1 mile)
- Right at the 2nd light onto E Mellen St. Continue approximately .6 miles over small bridge leading to Ft. Monroe
- Note signs for Decal and non Decal lanes

#### Directions from Virginia Beach/Norfolk

- Take I-64 West towards Richmond, VA to Hampton, VA.
- Take Exit 268 (Rte 169/ East Mallory St/Ft. Monroe). NOTE: First Exit after leaving the Hampton Roads Bridge Tunnel
- Left at the light onto S Mallory St (.1 mile)
- Right at the 2nd light onto E Mellen St. Continue approximately .6 miles over small bridge leading to Ft. Monroe
- Note signs for Decal and non Decal lanes

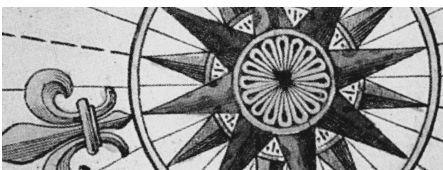
